Papers should be no more than 15 pages double-spaced, and presentations are limited to 20-30 minutes. Please complete the registration form (which will be forthcoming) and also include a one-page summary of your paper and a résumé. *We encourage you to submit all information via email, with your paper attached as a WORD document.* Please give us a printed version of your paper at the Congress. If requested, you will be given an opportunity to make revisions to your paper prior to submission for publication. Selected papers will be published in our journal, *Napoleonic Scholarship*, and/or on our website.

The official languages of the conference will be English, French and German, but we strongly encourage papers to be in English as there will not be translators available and our journal only publishes articles in English.
