These Congresses attract scholars from throughout the world. We encourage all people interested in this era to attend this Congress, whether or not they wish to give a paper. Plans for the Congress include a tour of Fort York, a possible wine and battlefield tour in the Niagara region, and a cruise on Lake Ontario.
